	attend multiple events per program year. All WIFV programs are open to the general public and we had more than 3500
	non-members attend the Wednesday Ones, Roundtables, master classes, special interest workshops, and ScriptDC. The meetings
	present industry leaders who share their insights and provide attendees with info to hone their skills to become better freelancers,
	employers, and employees. Professional development programs were hosted primarily online from July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024.
	We found a broader geographic representation since attendees didn't have to deal with commuting. WIFV nominates films
	annually for inclusion into the National Film Registry. WIFV continues its fiscal sponsorship program to support women-created
	media and added new projects to that program. Fiscally-sponsored projects received funds from a variety of individuals,
	foundations, and government entities.
